

given away as the need is great! We also contin-


ue to receive books of all kinds to put in the Book Nook and they are well received! Senior Food Box Ministry

Dear FCC Sisters and Brothers,

I feel like I have started this article in the same way several times in the past few years, but it bears repeating that we are in uncertain times with a lot of division and violent rhetoric. In all honesty, this divisive time has made the work of the church even more difficult. This division and hateful rhetoric will likely be around long past the election. Yet here we are, full of faith and hope. We must not only put on the armor of God, but we must also be the light of Jesus Christ before anything else. This season isn't just just about hoping that the candidate we want will be put into office, but that our faith will inform how we act, react, and carry ourselves in such a time as this. It is times like these that we most hold fast to the roots of our faith and look to the future with all Kingdom-building hopefulness. We must bear all things in love, even and especially when we do not understand someone else's perspective. Accountability and boundaries will be important tools for us to navigate these next few months, but don't forget the other tool you have: respond by asking questions (if you choose to engage). Pray and pray often! Jesus frequently taught by asking questions. Condemnation and hateful rhetoric (or any violence) are never solutions. They just create a bigger chasm between one another.

Let us move into this tricky season with compassionate caution and inquisitiveness. More than anything else, let us remain hopeful and steadfast in our faith of Jesus Christ that the way of peace, the way of unity, and the way of love are who we are to be together.

One of my favorite recitations is the following: All is well. All will be well. All is well. May it be so. Grace and Peace, Rev. Becky
